BEST OF THE MAHONING VALLEY

This overnight tour features the gems of Youngstown including the world-renowned Butler Institute of American Art, the country's first museum dedicated to works created solely by American artists; Fellows Riverside Gardens, a 12-acre public display garden; and Lanterman's Mill, a working gristmill constructed in 1846.

Your group will visit the Youngstown Historical Center (Steel Museum) for a unique look into the steel industry, or the Mahoning Valley Historical Society's Tyler History Center where the "Good Humor" bar was created. A hearty meal awaits at the professional dinner theater at the Dutch Village Event Center. Enjoy stops at The Amish Market, Ohio's first indoor Amish Market and White House Fruit Farm, an Ohio Century Farm Market known for their blueberry donuts!
